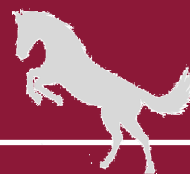
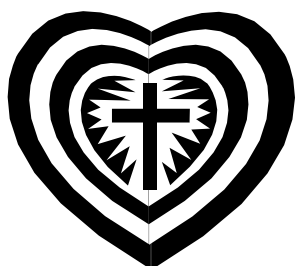

From the Principal...



Love One Another

“*Love one another*” is our theme for this 17th year of ministry for LHS. The theme comes from John 13:34-35. It starts with Jesus stating that He has a new command for His disciples to follow and that is to “*love one another*”. This is really not a new command since it was already recorded in Lev. 19:18, but it was new for the disciples to hear. Jesus was giving some last minute

instructions to His disciples since His death was just hours away. “*Love one another*” creates a bond, a brotherhood, a Christian community of people who belong to each other, who have a common purpose and who care for the needs of others. This is what He was trying to get through to His disciples before He left this earth. This brings great joy to know we are a part of this group but also brings great responsibility to care for one another. LHS continues to develop Christian Servant Leaders and loving one another is a vital part of this. Our students will be learning about this all year long. Each day of school will present opportunities for our students and staff to

demonstrate a caring love for one another. It is our prayer that our students and staff take those opportunities to care for one another.

The passage goes on to share the example that Jesus gave His disciples during His life on this earth of loving others and because of this love they too must “*love one another*”. This love that Jesus speaks of, and is our new command, is not the love that you get from the Hallmark cards or other warm and fuzzy messages. It is a love of action, of doing, of caring. Love is the distinguishing mark of Christ’s followers. It is our goal this school year to continue sharing Christ’s love with one

Cafeteria Information

Absolutely Everything will again provide lunches for the 2011-2012 school year. Lunches (including beverage) will cost \$4.00. Menus and order forms will generally be distributed within the last 10 days of the month. Students will be offered a choice of the main entrée, salad or fruit salad each day. Students may purchase lunch for the

whole month or pick and choose days. Although there are occasionally extra lunches available if a student is absent, students should not depend on there **always** being extra lunches for sale. In the event there are extra lunches available, they may be purchased for \$4. The monthly lunch order must be paid for in advance and

may not be charged to the student's account. Orders will not be accepted more than 3 days after the deadline.

Menus and order forms will be available at Orientation and on the website/Edline.

Fridays will again be Pizza Days and are separate from the catered lunches.

What is Scrip?

Fundraising While You Shop™. It's raising money for LHS while doing your everyday shopping. All you have to do is purchase gift cards from hundreds of America's favorite retailers through our school's Scrip program. Then use them instead of cash, credit card or check. For example, we have HEB, Wal-Mart, Target, Starbucks and local restaurants available in the school office for you to use for your daily shopping.

What are Scrip Fridays?

Those are the Fridays that a Scrip (gift card fundraising) order is placed.

When are they?

Orders will be placed every other Friday starting August 19th. This is also the Friday that, for your convenience, Scrip will be for sale in the school parking lot as you bring your students to school. But don't worry; if you can't be here in the morning, Scrip is always available in the

school office.

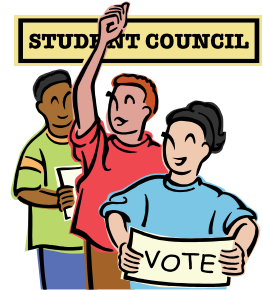

Counselor's Corner

For Parents and Students

- **Class Schedules:** Once the schedules have been distributed, changes may be requested for two weeks. Please note that requests may be made, but changes will be limited due to schedule constraints. Requests made after two weeks will not be possible, but may be revisited at the beginning of second semester.
- **Summer School:** If you went to summer school, please be sure to have your grades sent to LHS as soon as possible so we can update your records. If you are working on theology credits, remember to return workbooks or assignments to the appropriate teacher by the deadline.
- **Seniors:** A senior meeting will be arranged during the August/September time frame to see where the seniors are in the college search process.
- **College Transcript Requests:** Transcript request forms are available in the office. Students under 18 must have parents sign each request form. Once the forms are turned in, please allow for two weeks for them to be processed. Students requesting a letter of recommendation along with the transcript should expect a three week turnaround for them to be processed.
- **Senior Testing:** SAT and ACT information is sent to the school on a yearly basis. Students will be made aware of the testing dates through *Hoofbeats* and EDLINE. Please visit www.sat.collegeboard.com for SAT information and www.actstudent.org for ACT information. When signing up for each test, the student should be ready to pay for the test with a credit card.
- **Underclassmen Testing:** On October 12, Freshmen will take the EXPLORE test; Sophomores and Juniors will take the PSAT. More information will be available at a later date regarding these tests.

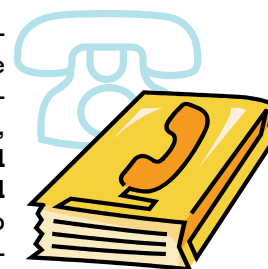
Vehicle Registration

Scrip is a term that means "substitute money". When you purchase Scrip, you're purchasing negotiable gift cards that are used just like cash. You can give these cards as gifts or use them to purchase everyday expenses like food, clothing and other essentials, and with every purchase, you earn revenue for our school. 2. Recycle

You can recycle paper at our campus 7 days a week. We earn money for paper dropped off at our green and yellow Abitibi Paper Retriever® bin.

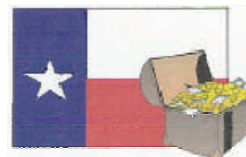
