Required Calculators

All students in any math class are required to have access to a graphing calculator. The models used at LHS are any TI-83 or TI-84 (preferred) models. This calculator needs to be available for use during school hours and at home. Some students may wish to share their calculators, but keep in mind that math classes are often taught during the same periods, and sharing may be difficult.

Although the price of the calculator is about \$100, they often go on sale in the weeks just before school begins. You might also try online auction sites. Students should expect to have the calculator by the second week of school. In order to minimize confusion, please clearly write the student's name on both the calculator and the cover. Also, the math department will keep a list of calculator serial numbers, to help identify the equipment should it be lost.

Please be sure to obtain one of the models listed. This machine will be used in all math classes for the next several years, and many colleges and universities use this calculator as well. Students using other graphing calculators, such as a Casio or a TI-85, may not be able to receive instruction in using this equipment from Lutheran High School teachers. In the past, students who have purchased other models have been very frustrated because of the difficulty in using them. In addition, please save and send to your child's math teacher the UPC bar code from the packaging. LHS can use this to receive free equipment for the school.

The math teachers at LHS are committed to providing the best teaching possible for your child, and we believe that this must include instruction using graphing technology. If you have any questions, please speak to any math teacher at Orientation Night.

Because it is used as the standard “textbook” for all theology classes at Lutheran High School, each student is required to have a personal copy of the *Concordia Self Study Bible*. We have available a supply of *Concordia Self Study Bibles that you may purchase this evening*.

Students who already own a Concordia Self Study Bible are not required to purchase a “special” copy to use in class, but you must have your Bible available each time your Theology class meets.
