About Lutheran High School and The New Greehey Campus

Empowered by the Gospel, Lutheran High School of San Antonio (LHS) nurtures faith and discipleship and promotes academic excellence to the glory of Jesus Christ. LHS is an accredited college preparatory Christian high school in the Lutheran education tradition. It nurtures faith and discipleship and promotes academic excellence to cultivate Christian servant leaders.

LHS is San Antonio's only Lutheran high school. It is supported by six congregations of the Lutheran Church Missouri Synod which make up the Lutheran High School Association.

LHS provides a unique educational environment in which students are empowered to find identity, meaning and purpose for their life in Christ while developing individual talents, skills and attitudes to achieve academically and make thoughtful Christian decisions.

In 2008, the Greehey Family Foundation contributed \$3 million to fund Phase I of the expansion of the school's campus. The donation - the single largest gift ever received by LHS - is being used to construct a new 40,000 square-foot building which will include the school's band and choir rooms, art room, biology, physics and chemistry labs, classrooms, dining area, gymnasium, weight room, and locker rooms. The project broke ground in July and is scheduled for completion in Spring 2009. LHS has been renamed "Lutheran High School of San Antonio – The Greehey Campus."

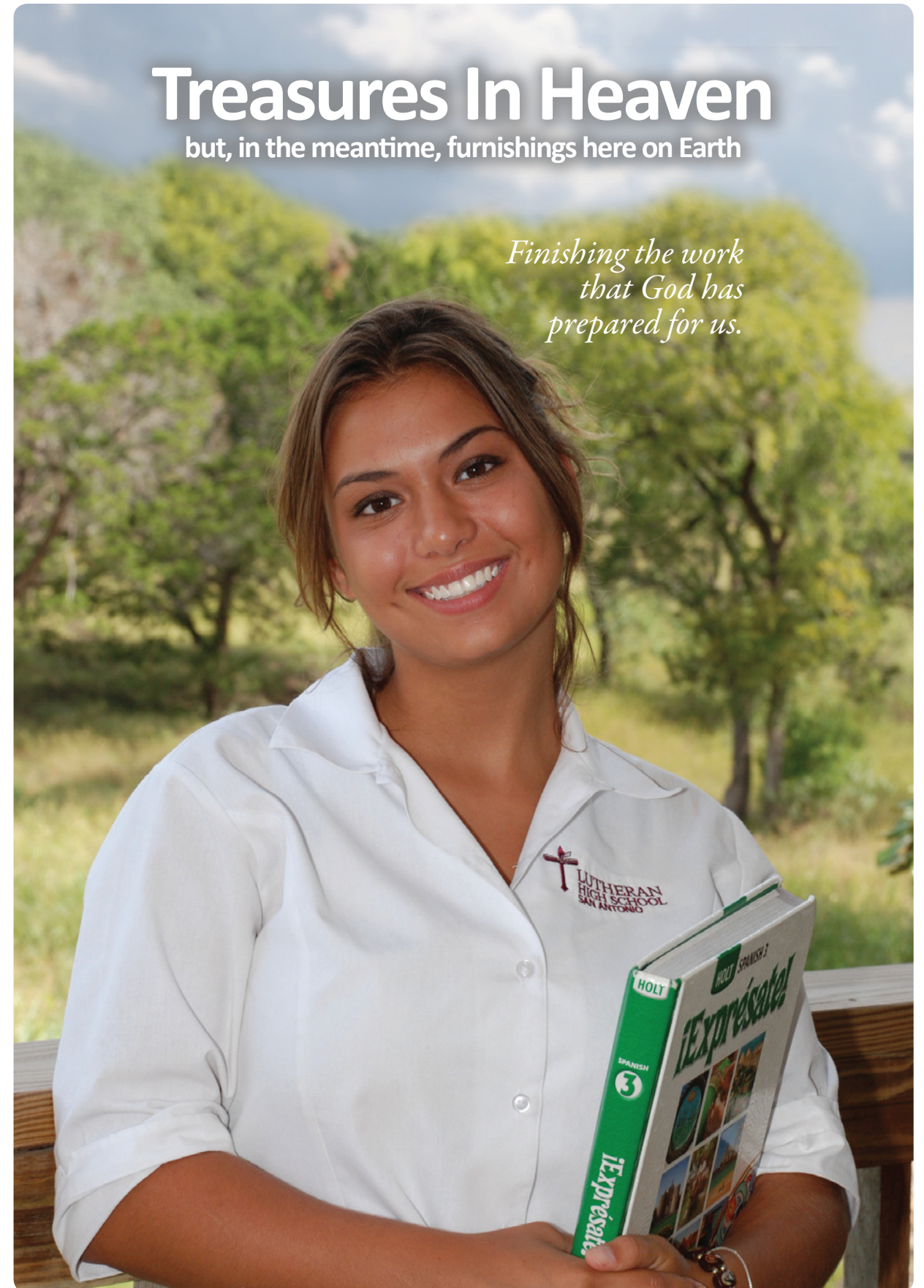

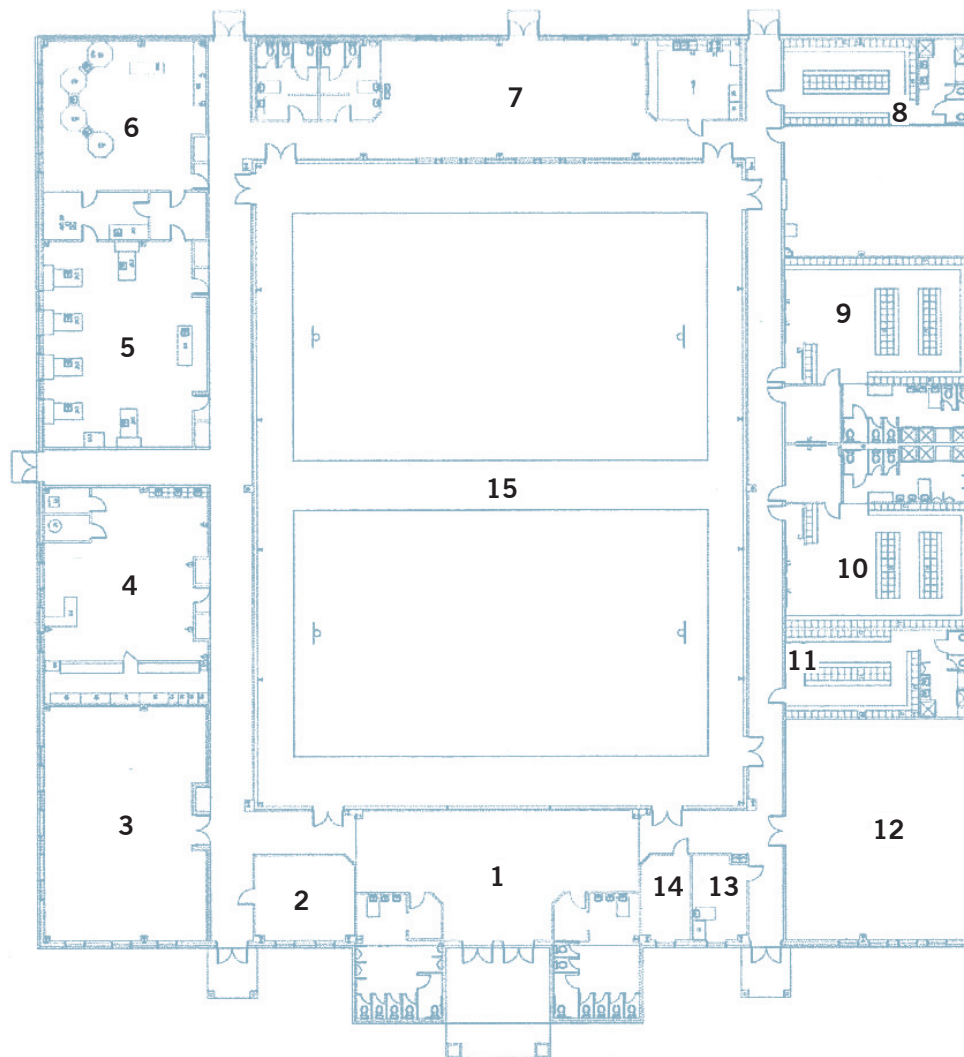

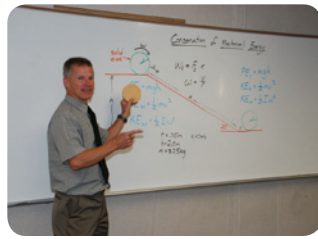
3. Band/Choir Room This 1,500 square-foot room brings music to your ears with room for 40 students to rehearse instrumentally or vocally on seated risers.

8. Girls Junior Varsity Locker Room Lockers, showers and dressing space for 70 students. Serves as locker room for visiting teams. Storage and restroom facilities included. *Available for \$15,000*



9. Girls Varsity Locker Room Oversized lockers to accommodate sports equipment, showers, dressing area and restroom facilities for 100 students. Includes coaching offices, lounge area, projector and whiteboard for play reviews.

10. Boys Varsity Locker Room Oversized lockers to accommodate sports equipment, showers, dressing area and restroom facilities for 100 students. Includes coaching offices, lounge area, projector and whiteboard for play reviews.

11. Boys Junior Varsity Locker Room Lockers, showers and dressing space for 70 students. Serves as locker room for visiting teams. Storage and restroom facilities included. *Available for \$15,000*



12. Weight Room To build healthy bodies to accompany students' growing minds and spirits, this 1,800 square-foot room offers athletes the opportunity to safely develop strength using machines and free weights.

13. Training Office This room is equipped to deal with athletic needs including special attention for injuries or other sports related issues. *Available for \$5,000*

14. Athletic Office A space for coaches and players to devise winning game plans for both sports and life. *Generously sponsored by Diane and Robert Marbut for \$5,000*



15. Gymnasium This multi-purpose space of nearly 13,000 square-foot will host a variety of events including basketball and volleyball games, summer camps, chapel, choir concerts, plays, graduation and more. Bleachers allow for several hundred spectators and windows at one end of the gym permit viewing from the café.
